A chance to learn the traditional art of frame basket making using willow. Make your own basket, under the watchful guidance of local basketmaker Nadine Anderson.

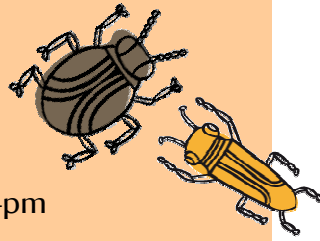

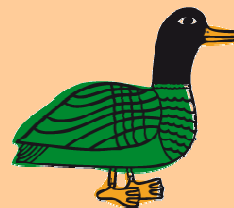
